## 3. Membership:

**Full:** Full membership permits attendance at all Vintage Arms Association (VAA) ranges, subject to local restrictions. A Full member has voting rights in the Association, and will receive the Association periodical, *The Primer*.

Life membership: is available for a single payment of ten times the Full (including Senior and Jersey) fee.

**Senior:** Full membership is open at a reduced rate to those of UK pensionable age.

Jersey: Full membership is open at a reduced rate to those residents in the States of Jersey CI.

**Family membership:** is open to the spouse or partner, and to any son or daughter under the age of twenty-one, of a Full member. A Family member may attend Association range meetings only while under the direct supervision of their respective Full member, or as directed by the Range Conducting Officer (RCO) on the day. A Family member has no voting rights in the Association and does not receive *The Primer*.

**Junior membership:** is open to all persons under the age of twenty-one as proposed by a Full VAA member. A Junior member may attend Association range meetings only while under the direct supervision of the proposing member, or as directed by the RCO on the day. A Junior member has no voting rights in the Association and does not receive *The Primer*.

**Corresponding membership:** is open to all. A Corresponding member has voting rights and will receive the Association periodical. A Corresponding member may not attend Association ranges other than as a Guest of the Association.

## 4. Conditions of Membership

- 4.1 Membership is conditional upon timely annual renewal, and a satisfactory attendance record. Membership may be terminated for cause at the sole discretion of the Committee.
- 4.2 Members will notify the committee of any change to their recorded personal details or FAC conditions within 30 days.
- 4.3 Membership ends March 31<sup>st</sup> on which date all membership rights and range access cease. A period of grace until April 30<sup>th</sup> may be allowed at the discretion of the Committee to renew without forfeiture of membership. This period does not extend membership in any way. A lapsed member failing to renew by April 30th is deemed to have resigned from the Association. Former members wishing to re-join after April 30<sup>th</sup> should submit a new application for approval by the Committee.
- 4.4 Members will observe all local range regulations concerning permitted ammunition type, muzzle energy and the ballistic performance of commercial and hand-loaded ammunition. The decision of the Range Conducting Officer (RCO) is final in all matters relating to range safety and security. Disputes must be directed to the Committee, and not to the RCO or to any third party.
- 4.5 Members will carry a valid membership card and, where appropriate, a Shooter Certification Card, at all times while on the range. Those who fail to comply may be refused entry.
- 4.6 No photographic or video recording equipment may be used at any Association meeting without prior permission from a Committee member. No person may be photographed or recorded in any format without their express permission while on Association business. Photographic, audio or video material relating to any Association activity may not be discussed on any social media site, uploaded to the internet or sent to any media organisation without the prior written consent of the Committee Chairman.
- 4.7 Members shooting on Ministry of Defence (Landmarc) ranges and at NRA Bisley must hold a National Rifle Association Shooter Certification Card (SCC) authorised by a Home Office Approved club. Members requiring a SCC from the VAA should contact the Honorary Secretary, <u>secretary@vintagearms.org.uk</u>. All cards issued by the VAA must be returned on cessation of membership, or if requested by the Committee.
- 4.8 Guests are permitted only if they are members of a Home Office Approved club, or hold a personal Firearm Certificate, or are attending an official Association Guest Day as published on the Association website and in the periodical.

## 5. Data Privacy

The Vintage Arms Association (VAA) is both controller and processor of its members data and may use the information provided on the application form and in any other communication in all matters as stated under the VAA Data Privacy Notice. The VAA reserve the right to change the Data Privacy Notice at any time and will notify members of any substantial updates.
